Directions from the north: Take your favorite Road to I-287 South, Exit

1B. Immediate right off exit ramp (careful, Main Street traffic has right of way) to U.S. 1 South. Wick Shopping Plaza (anyone remember Edison Lanes?) is exactly 2.5 miles ahead on your right. If you take the Plainfield Ave exit (this is Fulton Street), HomeTown Buffet will be on your right.

<u>Directions from the south</u>: Take your favorite highway (in most instances this will be NJ 18) to U.S. 1 North. Go over the Morris Goodkind bridge. 0.9 miles past the bridge are the exits for Plainfield Avenue, Follow the signs for Piscataway/Dunellen. Follow the cup handle behind Wallgreens and then back across US 1. Immediately after crossing US 1 turn right on Fulton Street, then left into HomeTown Buffet's parking lot.
